Policy & Advocacy Committee-

2022 Priorities: Advocacy, Shop the Battlefords campaign (including Canada Shop Local project), and community reputation.

Connectivity Committee-

2022 Priorities: Membership Recruitment and Development, Events and Forums, Communications, Website redevelopment project.

Sustainability Committee-

2022 Priorities: Organizational Sustainability, Accreditation, Membership Analysis (updating business database), Governance, and TEN Labour Market project.

BBEX Committee-

2022 Priorities: Plan and execute a 29th Annual Battlefords Business Excellence Awards program and event.

The Following Committees are exclusive to members of the Current Board of Directors

Executive Committee-

- -Composed of the Executive Officers of the Chamber
- -2 main functions include:
- A) it shall be their duty to advise on any matters referred to them by the Board or the full Chamber
- B) They shall be authorized to act in emergencies, subject to approval of the Board at the next meeting.

• ADHOC—Nominations Committee (1 month) -

- -This is an internally restricted committee and serves for approximately 1 month in the fall of each year.
- The board shall annually appoint this committee on or before October 1st. They shall consist of not fewer than three and not more than seven directors.
- Their sole purpose is to request member support in preparing a slate on nominees to run in election to serve on the board of the Battlefords Chamber of Commerce for the next two-year term.
