Executive Committee

- Composed of the Executive Officers of the Chamber
- **-** 2 main functions include:
 - A) It shall be their duty to advise on any matters referred to them by the Board or the full Chamber
 - B) They shall be authorized to act in emergencies, subject to approval of the Board at the next meeting.

ADHOC—Nominations Committee (1 month)

- This is an internally restricted committee and serves for approximately 1 month in the fall of each year.
- The board shall annually appoint this committee on or before October 1st. They shall consist of not fewer than three and not more than seven directors.
- Their sole purpose is to request member support in preparing a slate on nominees to run in election to serve on the board of the Battlefords Chamber of Commerce for the next two-year term.
